Driving Directions to Northstar-at-Tahoe

From the Bay + Sacramento Areas:

Go East on Interstate 80. From Sacramento, roughly 1 hour 45 minutes (103 miles).

Take Highway 267 Exit #188B. This is the new by-pass route. It is just after the last Truckee Exit Travel South on Highway 267 for approx. 6 miles, Turn Right onto Northstar Dr.

From Reno:

Go West on Interstate 80 for roughly 30 minutes (30 miles)

Take Highway 267 Exit #188

Travel South on Highway 267 for approx 6 miles, Turn Right onto Northstar Dr.

Parking and Meeting Locations:

Park: Handicapped and paid parking is available at The Village. The closest parking for participants with Handicapped placards is near the The Village Transit Center loop. More disabled parking places are located at the Guest Drop off area. Please refer to online map. (http://www.northstaratahroe.com/info/ski/the-village/village_directory_summer.asp) *Parking is also available at Castle Peak Park & Ride (red & blue lots) near the roundabout just after turning on to onto Northstar Drive. From there take the free Northstar shuttle to the Village.*

Meet: Your Disabled Sports instructor will meet you in The Village, Copper Lane, Room 1801. (http://www.northstaratahroe.com/info/ski/the-village/village_directory_summer.asp) To get there coming from the Transit Center, follow Copper Lane past the burrito shop "North of the Boarder." The room is the first one on the right just past the steps leading up to the ice rink, basically one level below Starbucks.

Elevators: The most direct elevator from the Shuttle or Guest Drop off is in the Iron Horse North building (adjacent to Octagon building). Guests with disabilities, who require assistance to the Gondola or up the mountain, please contact Northstar Public Safety staff at anytime 562.2259 so they may assist you.

Reservations: are required and are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

We suggest calling two to four weeks in advance to reserve the dates you desire. Contact reservations at Disabled Sports USA Far West 530-581-4161x206.

Payments and Cancellations:

We require full payment in advance to guarantee your reservation.

Payments are non-refundable. When you make your reservation, consider the possibility that the mountains may receive heavy snowfall the day you plan to ski and chains may be required on the roads you are traveling. **If notice of cancellation is received by 12-noon the day before your lesson, a credit will be issued which can be used towards another lesson.** Cancellations made after 12-noon the day before your lesson will not receive a refund or credit.
